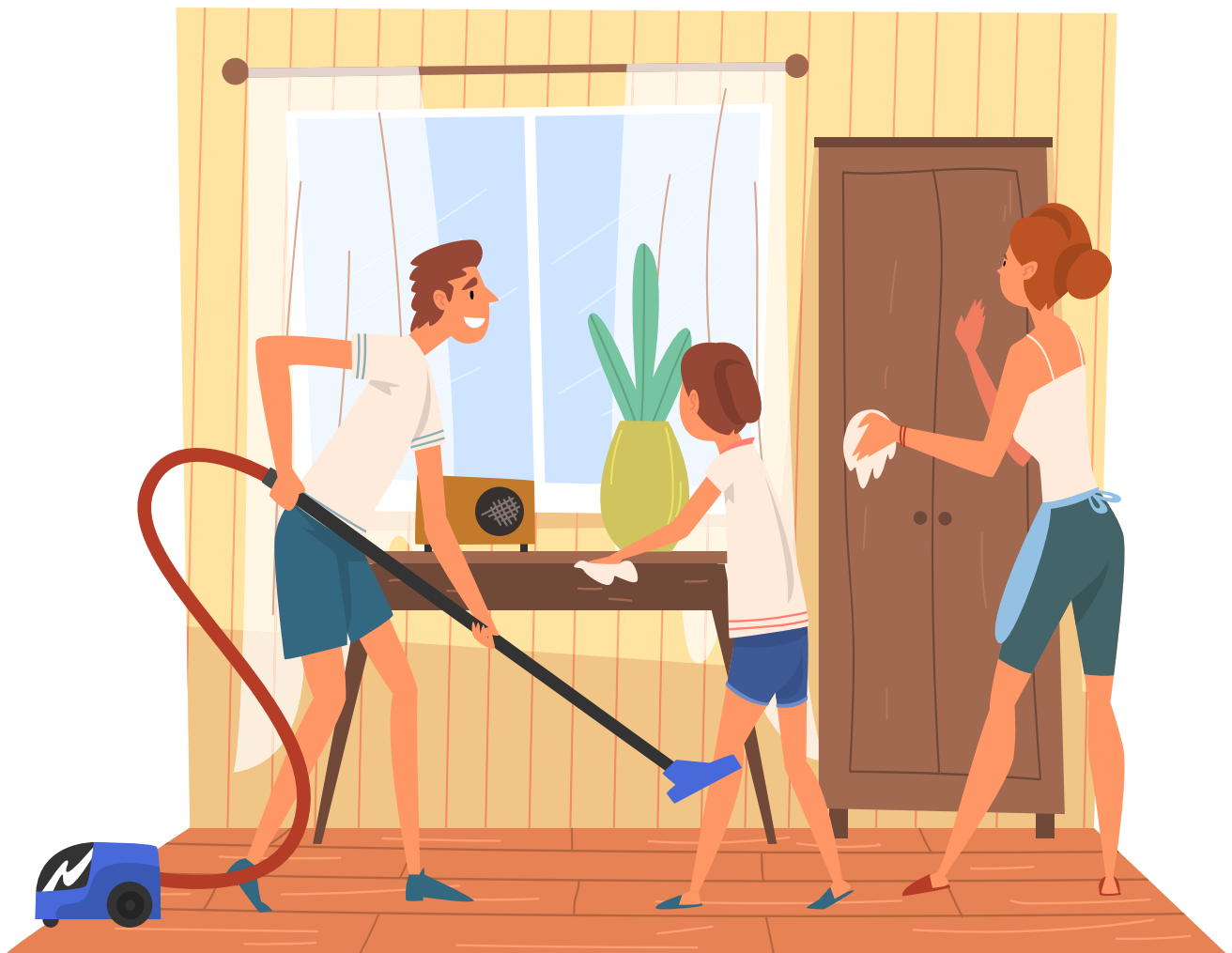

# SWIPE OUR ZONE-BASED CHORE SYSTEM ...

What is a “Chore Zone”?

A “Chore Zone” refers to a specific area or room within a house that’s designated for cleaning or maintenance.

The idea behind organizing chores into zones is to break down the tasks associated with household upkeep into manageable chunks.

This approach helps to ensure that high-traffic areas of the home receive regular attention and that cleaning tasks are distributed evenly among household members.

Of course, zone-based chores will be unique to each family.

That said, when you begin something new, it’s nice to have a clear place to start. For this reason, we provided the exact Zone Cards our family uses.



# SWIPE OUR ZONE-BASED CHORE SYSTEM

## A few things to note:

Our zone system was created specifically for children. For this reason, we don't consider our "Zone Time" a time to deep clean.

Instead, our zones are dedicated to high-traffic, public-facing areas that need to be kept tidy on a daily basis.

You will see this reflected in the tasks associated with each zone.

In our family, "Zone Time" happens immediately after we eat breakfast and brush teeth—and before we start our homeschool day.
